We can help you.

Don't suffer in silence, you don't have to leave and become homeless. You don't have to leave your home if you don't want to go.

A Next Link crisis response worker will offer you immediate help with your situation.

What we offer

A crisis response worker will offer you immediate help with your situation including:

- someone to talk things over with
- forming a safety plan
- help you to go to court to get legal protection
- work with the police to keep you safe
- make your house secure
- support your children

How long will the support last?

The crisis worker will work with you for 4 weeks and then in you wish you can have ongoing support from our tenancy support workers for up to six months.

We are here to help you stay in your home and be safe.

We can help you stay and keep your violent partner away and help make your house safe.

What help can we give your children?

A children's resettlement worker will meet with you and your children and offer the following:

- someone for the children to talk to
- help with feeling safe
- help with finding them things to do sessions

How can you contact us?

- You can phone us directly
- You can go to your local housing office and they will let us know
- You can ask the police to contact us
- If you are in the casualty department ask them to contact us
