What we offer

- finding things for the children to do
- access to training and education
- volunteering and work experience
- help with ongoing legal issues
- becoming more confident

What help can we give your children?

A children's worker will meet with you and your children and offer the following:

- someone for the children to talk to
- help with finding new schools and nurseries
- help with finding things to do after school
- help with settling into a new home and new school

How long will the support last?

The support will be reduced as you become more settled and could be for up to 6 months.
