 - If you are from the LGBTQ+ community
 - If you are at risk from 'Honour' based abuse or forced marriage
 - If you are deaf or have a hearing problem

- At night there will be an ansaphone but don't worry, you can still speak to someone who can help you
 - You can contact the police and they will help you
 - If you need medical attention call 999 or go to hospital

- Take your own front door key with you
 - Bring clothing and other essential items
 - Please bring proof of income and identity with you
 - Keep our telephone number in a safe place.

What's it like living in a safe house?

- This house has a secret location.
- The house is clean and well equipped.
- You have a key to your own room and the front door.
- You cook your own food.
- There will be support for you from a male key worker.
- You have your own privacy.
- There will be other men in similar circumstances to whom you can talk
- You can get help with housing, finances, legal support, mental and physical health, education, employment and parenting.
